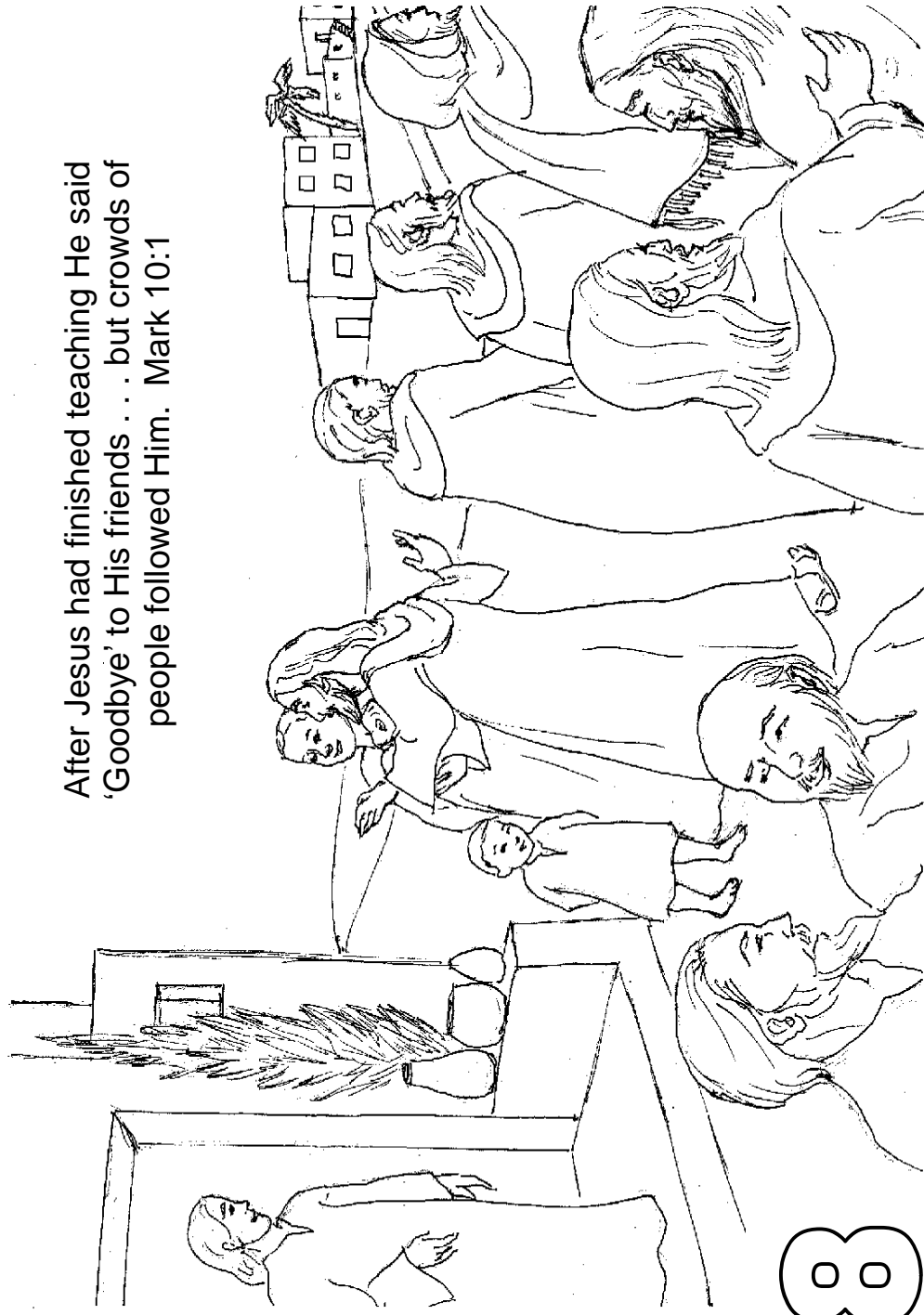


We made a big mistake.
