







Every morning the crippled man's friends took him to beg at the Temple gate.




Christians knew the joy of serving Jesus. They saw many miracles.

Jesus said, "As much as you have done it into the least of these ... you have done it unto ME." Matthew 25:35




Many people passed by every day. Many gave him their coins.





It was time for the evening prayer. Peter and John were on their way up to the temple in Jerusalem to pray.




It will soon be 3 o'clock

The crowd came running to see what was happening. They were filled with wonder and awe.




His faith has made him well.




God had given special instructions to His people.

Peter and John joined many others every afternoon for worship.


We want to obey Him.




Isn't this the man who used to beg at the Temple Gate?

I cannot believe what I am seeing.





When the crippled man saw Peter and John, he shouted to them.

This man had been crippled all his life. He had never been able to walk or jump.






Jesus can heal you. Do you believe this?
