





But he was a leper.




Naaman came home praising God. The little captive maid was right. There was a man of God in Israel.

The name of the man of God is Elisha.


I want them to know how important you are to me.

His skin was like that of a baby.


Praise the God of Heaven. Let us go and tell the prophet.

The King gave Naaman the letter. He also gave him silver, gold and beautiful clothes to give as gifts to the man of God.



He dipped himself once, twice, three . . . times — just like he was told to do.



The King of Israel tore his clothes when he read the letter. He thought it was a trap. 2 Kings 5:7.




Am I God? Only God can heal.

So Naaman changed his mind and went down to the River Jordan.




Maybe you are right.
